The owner of Crowell & Co. Interiors puts the spotlight on Music City makers.

Hannah Crowell doesn't consider herself a traditional designer, but she is big on family traditions. "A home should be a real reflection of who you are and who your family is, yet nothing should be too precious or overthought," she says. Crowell has ties to country music (her parents are Rosanne Cash and Rodney Crowell), and the instruments that she's inherited often double as décor. In her home, she pairs these treasured heirlooms with found objects sourced from vintage shops and design boutiques. Area favorites include GasLamp Antiques, Apple and Oak for "gorgeous vintage rugs," and Wilder, a store that carries everything from colorful sofas to abstract lighting.
